YEAR OF CONSECRATED LIFE. Redemptorists. This month a good number of Saints will be remembered in the Church, some of them were founders of religious congregations: 01 August, St Alphonsus Liguori, founder of the Redemptorists; 03 August, St Peter Julian Eymard, founder of the Blessed Sacrament Fathers; 08 August, St Dominic, the Dominican Order; 11 August, St Clare, the poor Clares; 12 August, St Jane Frances de Chantal, the Congregation of the Visitation; 19 August, St John Eudes, the Congregation of Jesus and Mary and the Order of Our Lady of Charity; 20 August, St Bernard, the primary builder of the Cistercian Order; 25 August, St Joseph Calasanz, the Piarists Order; 28 August, St Augustine, the Augustinians.

One needs to remember that on 15 August, the church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption. There is a religious congregation named after the mystery of the Assumption. St Marie Eugénie Milleret founded the Religious of the Assumption.

It may be good to say something about the Redemptorists, their longer title is Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, CSsR. The origin was desire of St Alphosus to minister to poor people of Naples. He saw that they were dying with knowing eternal truths. He started the popular practice of “parish missions” where priests would stay for a week in remote places teaching and administering the sacraments.

Pope Pius IX entrusted to the Redemptorists the Byzantine Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help, an icon that shows the Blessed Mother with Child Jesus, the child Jesus holding the instruments of his passion. Now part of their mission is the promotion of the devotion to Our Mother of Perpetual Help.
