**YEAR OF CONSECRATED LIFE.** The following is a excerpt from the letter to consecrated men and women entitled *Rejoice.* "Hail, Mother of Joy. Rejoice, full of grace (Lk 1:28), "the greeting of the angel to Mary is an invitation to joy, to a deep joy, announcing the end of sadness [...]. It is a greeting that marks the beginning of the Gospel, the Good News". Alongside Mary joy expands. The Son she carries in her womb is the God of joy, of contagious, engaging delight.
