YEAR OF CONSECRATED LIFE. Extra Vows. The past weeks this space focused on the three evangelical counsels or three vows: poverty, chastity, and obedience. However, there are some congregation or institutes of religious that add an additional vow to their members. Last week the example given was the Society of Jesus and their fourth vow, direct obedience to the pope in regard to mission. The Benedictines also have a fourth vow, the vow of stability. Stability for Benedictines involves the promise to remain and live out the rest of one's life in the monastery community which they enter, not moving about from Monastery to monastery, or place to place. The vow frees them from the temptation of thinking that there is better place than where they are.

CHILDREN'S MASS. Next Sunday, 05 July, the first Sunday of July, the 11:00 a.m. mass will be mass for children. Those who prefer a more solemn celebration of the mass are encouraged to attend the Saturday 6:00 p.m. mass. The choir will sing on Saturday evening.
